

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS RED RIVER, ATCHAFALAYA & BAYOU BOEUF LEVEE DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING April 5, 2022

The Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District met at its regular meeting place, 10 Calvert Drive, Alexandria, Louisiana on Tuesday, April 5, 2022 at 9:00 o'clock a.m. The following were present: Mr. Chris Roy, Jr., President and Rapides Parish Commissioner; Mr. Christopher Dauzat, Vice President and Avoyelles Parish Commissioner; Mr. Andrew C. Leon, St. Landry Parish Commissioner; Warren Byrd, Executive Director; and Guests.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Byrd. The roll call of the meeting was performed by Mr. Byrd; Mr. Chris Roy, Jr., Mr. Christopher Dauzat and Mr. Andrew C. Leon were present. Others in attendance were asked to identify themselves and offer any public comments they may have regarding the agenda. No public comments were made.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District discussed a Permit Request from Alon Refining for excavation activities near the Atchafalaya Westbank Levee in St. Landry Parish; and,

WHEREAS, Alon Refining is requesting to excavate the foundation of Tank 80-06 to a depth of 5 feet and to a diameter of 154 feet; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed excavation will be backfilled with limestone; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed activity is approximately 715 feet from the toe of the Atchafalaya Westbank Levee; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District in legal session assembled this 5th day of April 2022 does hereby agree to grant permission for the project as described, provided before the project begins, the applicant is hereby required to receive written approval from the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development Public Works and Water Resources Division and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Operations Division for the project as described in the documentation provided with the permit request to the levee board; and,



WHEREAS, Ms. Moreland is requesting to drive 15 wooden poles 10 foot into the ground in order to construct an elevated foundation for a manufactured home; and,

WHEREAS, Southeast Engineering out of Lafayette designed the foundation structure based on the geotechnical investigation performed on site; and,

WHEREAS, the project site is located approximately 350 feet from the flood side of the West Atchafalaya River Levee; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District in legal session assembled this 5th day of April 2022 does hereby agree to grant permission for the project as described, provided before the project begins, the applicant is hereby required to receive written approval from the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development Public Works and Water Resources Division and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Operations Division for the project as described in the documentation provided with the permit request to the levee board; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District discussed a Permit Request from Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI, Inc.) for soil borings near the Southbank Levee in Rapides Parish; and,

WHEREAS, PSI, Inc. is requesting to drill four soil borings for the purpose of determining the subsurface conditions and geotechnical engineering properties of the soil in order to provide recommendations for use in a design project; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed project is located near Hwy. 457 in Rapides Parish; and,

WHEREAS, the bore locations are near the Southbank Levee Segment; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District in legal session assembled this 5th day of April 2022 does hereby agree to grant permission for the project as described, provided before the project begins, the applicant is hereby required to receive written approval from the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development Public Works and Water Resources Division and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Operations Division for the project as described in the documentation provided with the permit request to the levee board; and,

WHEREAS, CapturePoint, LLC recently purchased and assumed responsibility of the Krotz Springs Field Unit in St. Landry Parish; and,

WHEREAS, they intend to initiate injection of carbon dioxide into the Field Unit in order to increase production; and,

WHEREAS, the existing ROA only allows the reinjection of gas produced from the Field Unit only; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the ROA would allow them to inject additional substances including carbon dioxide in order to increase production; and,

WHEREAS, it appears at some point, RRABB relinquished all rights and title to this particular tract but yet retained the undivided mineral interest; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya & Bayou Boeuf Levee District in legal session assembled this 5th day of April 2022 does hereby agree to execute an amended Royalty Owners Agreement for the Krotz Springs Field Unit.
